Lesson Plan #3

Grade level: 6th

Subject area: Language Arts

Materials needed: Notebook, pencil, whiteboard, computer, alphabet card

Standards: W.4 Produce clear and coherent writing in which the development, organization, and style are appropriate to task, purpose, and audience.

Objectives:

Students will write a paper on a self-selected topic that is clearly organized, well thought-out, and contains personal style.

Learning activities:

- Begin by discussing task, purpose and audience. Have students think of a task to write about, a purpose and an audience to address.
- Once students have thought of TAP, give students class time to work on a rough draft focusing on development.
 - Sammy: Allow him to go on the computer and find a recipe for his favorite food or find the recipe for him print out the recipe and have him write the ingredients. Task: To make his favorite food, Audience: himself, and purpose: to buy groceries. Give Sammy an alphabet chart for reference if needed.
- Next class period will focus on the second draft, emphasizing organization and style.
 - Sammy: ask Sammy to think of what else he would like to have with his favorite food (beverage, salad, dessert, etc.) and work on listing these on his grocery list.

The final draft will then be a polished writing.

Assessment:

The final paper will be graded by a rubric

Sammy's paper should include a complete grocery list.
